CARING CONVERSATIONS

DEVOTIONS



Read: Psalm 95:1-7a slowly three times.

It can be difficult in today's world where the news gives us negative local and international reports of violence and injustices to see how God reigns now through Christ the King. Throughout history the people of God have often been challenged by the claim that God is present and opposing evil, death, and destruction. During the week remember the claim that God reigns through the cross of Christ. Remember to worship God with thanksgiving and songs of praise.

Make a joyful noise and sing hymns of praise including the "Hymn of the Week", *Lord, I Lift Your Name On High*.

SERVICE



In Matthew 25:35-40 followers of Jesus participate in the reign of God by acts of loving service. It is a way to serve Christ himself. In this text Jesus lifts up a number of ways to serve others: feeding others, giving water to the thirsty, clothing people, caring for the sick, and visiting the imprisoned. Reflect and give thanks for how you are part of this service to others and commit to some specific action of care this next week.

RITUALS AND TRADITIONS



Hymns are sung prayers. Sing and/or pray this week a number of Christian songs that give praise for the reign of God. Here are some examples to consider:

Praise to the Lord, the Almighty*
